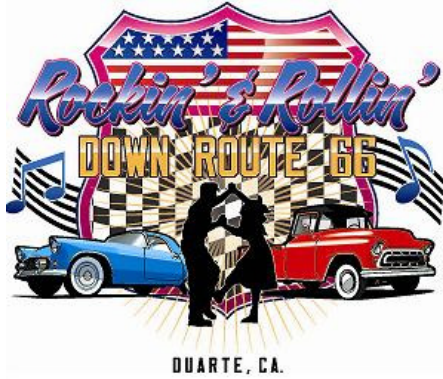


# *From Mt. Everest to Route 66*

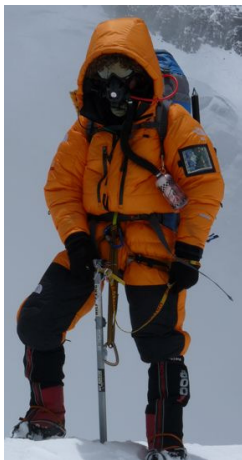

Jordan Romero has already climbed to the top of five of the world's highest mountains. He was only 10 when he stood on the summit of Mt. Kilimanjaro, in Africa, the first mountain in his quest to climb the highest peaks on all seven continents. Next came Mt. Kosciuszko in Australia; followed by Mt. Elbrus, Russia; Aconcagua, South America; Mt. McKinley (Denali), Alaska; and Carstensz Pyramid (Puncak Jaya), Oceania. On May 22, 2010 he reached the summit of Mt. Everest, the highest mountain in the world at 29,035 feet. Only one mountain remains for Jordan to fulfill his dream, Vinson Massif in Antarctica. Jordan's team is scheduled to leave for Antarctica in December 2010. *But before that his next climb will be onto the seat of a classic car leading Duarte's Route 66 Parade.*
